Japan Hands over Warehouse Equipment to Jordan Hashemite Charity Organization (JHCO)

The handover ceremony of warehouse equipment was held at the aid storage of Jordan Hashemite Charity Organization (JHCO) in Zarqa on Wednesday January 10th 2018, in the presence of H.E. Mr. Hidenao Yanagi, Ambassador of Japan to the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan and Mr. Ayman Riyad Al Mufleh, Secretary General of JHCO.

In 2016, the Government of Japan extended to JHCO a grant in total of sixty four thousand and ninety six US dollars (US\$ 64,096) for the implementation of the project titled "The Project for the Improvement of Aid Storage Facility in Zarqa" through the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects, so called GGP aiming to improve basic human needs at the grass-roots level through NGOs and local governments.

The overall objective of the project is to enhance the ability of JHCO in providing relief supply to vulnerable people including Syrian refugees through the provision of forklifts and shelves used in the aid storage.

Under Japanese Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects, Japan has extended more than 9 million US dollars for 141 projects to NGOs, schools, hospitals, and local governments in Jordan since 1993.
