

Site Visit on the Emergency Grant Aid

On January 8, 2018, H.E Hidenao Yanagi, Ambassador of Japan visited El Manshiya city hall in Mafraq Governorate, and he was briefed on the usage of a water truck, which is part of “Emergency Grant Aid for Syrian Refugees and IDPs in 2013” where 69 garbage trucks, 16 wheel loaders, 9 water trucks, and 9 sludge trucks were provided to the Government of Jordan.

Mr. Mohammad Odeh Al Khaldi, Municipal President explained that social services including water supply and garbage disposal have been overstretched due to the large influx of Syrian refugees into the host communities in Jordan, including El Manshiya city. The Municipal President said that the water truck installed by the Japanese aid has been used to supply water to vulnerable households and contributed to the improvement of the social services in the city. During the meeting, he expressed his expectation for the further assistance from the Government of Japan, and also mentioned that activities of a Japanese NGO (JEN: Japan Emergency NGO) was highly valued in the city.
