Termination of “Community Cohesion Grants Mechanism: CCGM”

On 16 December, 2018, H.E. Mr. Hidenao YANAGI, Ambassador of Japan to Jordan, attended at “the Partnership Forum for Social Cohesion in Jordan” organized by UNDP and made a remark at the opening ceremony of the event. Government of Japan extended an assistance amount 12,650,000 USD to the UNDP project titled “*Support to Counter-terrorism, Stabilization and de-radicalization in Jordan*” in 2016 and “Community Cohesion Grant Mechanism” is one of the components of the project funded by Japan.
