

Reception for international organizations aiming at enhancing cooperation

On March 25th, H.E. Mr. Hidenao YANAGI, Ambassador of Japan hosted the reception for international organizations and over sixty representatives from international organization, Jordan government, JICA and Japanese NGOs participated in the reception. H.E. Dr. Mary KAWAR, Minister of Planning and International Cooperation, H.E. Mr. Anders Pedersen, UN Resident and Humanitarian Coordinator, and Ambassador Khalid Shawabkeh, Director General for the International organization, MOFA as well as Ambassador Hidenao Yanagi made their remarks at the beginning of the reception.

In February 2019, Japan decided to extend its new assistance to projects by 9 international organizations in Jordan with the purpose of humanitarian assistance and social stability to Syrian refugees and host communities, which amounts to approximately 16.5 million US dollars form its supplementary budget of FY 2018.

The reception was held aiming at enhancing networks among our partners such as Jordan government, international organizations, JICA, and Japanese NGOS, and also increasing in the number of Japanese nationals working at the United Nations and other international organizations.
