## The New Contribution to WFP Jordan Office

February, 2019, Government of Japan has decided to allocate 785,714 US dollars to the WFP Jordan for the implementation of the project titled "Jordan Transitional Interim Country Strategic Plan (2018-2019)" by the supplementary budget of FY 2018. With the new assistance from Japan, WFP will provide food assistance for Syrian refugees in the refugee camps and vulnerable communities in Jordan.
