Government of Japan provided funding assistance of 1 million USD to ICRC project in Jordan in 2018 and decided to extend a new assistance of approximately 900, 000 USD in February this year.

Many of the attendees of the ceremony expressed their appreciation for Japanese support to the activities of ICRC and host communities in the water sector.
