

The New Contribution to UNHCR Jordan Office

In February 2020, Government of Japan has decided to allocate 1,090,909 US dollars to the UNHCR Jordan for the implementation of the project titled “Protection and Assistance to Syrian Refugees in Jordan” by the supplementary budget of FY 2019. With the new assistance from Japan, UNHCR will provide vocational trainings, self-development and recreation activities for Syrian refugees in the Zaatari and Azraq camps in Jordan.

February 20, 2020, Ambassador Mr. Hidenao Yanagi has a meeting with Mr. Dominik Bartsch, new UNHCR Representative in Jordan, in the occasion of launching the project. Mr. Dominik Bartsch expressed his appreciation for the Japan’s long-standing commitment to community centers in Zaatari and Azraq camps as well as the strong partnership with UNHCR since the onset of the Syrian crisis.
