

Courtesy Visits by Ambassador Shimazaki to  
H.E. Eng. Mohammad Najjar, Minister of Water and Irrigation,

On 21 January 2021, H.E. Mr. SHIMAZAKI Kaoru, Ambassador of Japan to Jordan, paid a courtesy visit to H.E. Eng. Mohammad Al-Najjar, Minister of Water and Irrigation. Ambassador Shimazaki reaffirmed that Japan will continue to support Jordan's water sector, which is one of the priorities of Japan's assistance to Jordan. H.E. Eng.
