Embassy of Japan in Jordan decided to extend the deadline of applications for Grant Assistance for Grass-roots Human Security Projects (GGP) for the first half year of 2021 until Thursday, 3rd June. As one of the ODA (Official Development Assistance) schemes of the Japanese Government, GGP supports small-scale projects directly benefiting the grassroots level as well as contributing to the socio-economic development of developing countries. In Jordan, GGP was launched in 1990 and as of May 2021, 150 projects have been implemented by non-government organizations (NGOs), educational institutions, and other non-profit organizations.

(Eligible organizations)

- Municipalities financially independent from Jordanian central government
- •NGOs (Non-profit organization) legally registered under Jordanian authorities
- •Continuous activities for more than 2 years in Jordan
- Implementing economic and social development projects to serve local communities in Jordan
