**Completion Ceremony of Japanese Grant Assistance Project
“The Project for the Enhancement of Border Security
at Al-Karamah Border Crossing in Jordan”**

On January 23, 2022, H.E. Mr. Kaoru SHIMAZAKI, Ambassador of Japan to Jordan attended the completion ceremony of the Japanese grant assistance titled “the Project for the Enhancement of Border Security at Al-Karamah Border Crossing in Jordan”

In 2012, the government of Japan decided to extend a grant of approximately Four million Seven hundred and Seventy thousand Jordanian Dinars (4,770,000 JD) for the project with a view to installing and replacing security screening and customs inspection equipment such as X-ray machines.

In his remarks at the ceremony, H.E. Ambassador Mr. Shimazaki stated: *“I sincerely hope that this project will contribute to improving the security screening and customs inspection at this border and enabling the secure and active exchange of people and goods between Jordan and Iraq in the future which are essential for the political stability and economic prosperity of the region.”*

Attendees from the government of Jordan expressed their appreciation for Japanese generous support, hoping that this project will contribute to safety in the region and smoother customs procedures.
