

Visit to Our Lady of Peace Center for Persons with Disabilities by Ambassador of Japan

On 12 January 2023, Mr. OKUYAMA Jiro, Ambassador of Japan to Jordan, paid a visit to Our Lady of Peace Center for Persons with Disabilities in Amman. During the visit, Ambassador OKUYAMA observed activities of the center, which provides rehabilitation services to all patients, including Iraqi and Syrian refugees injured in the war. The center is a recipient of Japanese Government's assistance under the scheme called Grant Assistance for Grass-Roots Human Security Projects.
